Angelua "Angie" Renee Wester, 58, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, November 3, 2021 at Menorah Medical Center in Overland Park, Kansas.

All her good deeds came back to reward her when she had to fight for her life 25 years ago. The love and support she received from family and friends rallied her body as she beat the odds to survive toxic shock syndrome. She returned home to see her boys grow into accomplished young men.
