In October 2014, she relocated to Overland Park, KS to live with and enjoy time with her daughter. She thoroughly enjoyed living in the Kansas City metropolitan area up until her passing.

Betty is survived by her daughter Bonnie Weyer (Overland Park, KS), a sister, Mary Ann Bothwell (Columbus, NE), two brothers, Ken Bothwell (Lincoln, NE) and Arlyn Bothwell (Redding, CA), and several nieces, nephews, and cousins.
