Born May 21st, 1936, to Joseph and Minnie (Marsh) Frerking. Bonita graduated from Concordia High School in 1953. She moved to Kansas City after graduation and worked at the Plaza Bank for 16 years. She then went to work for Ford Motor Credit and retired after 29 years. After retirement, Bonita moved back to Concordia to care for her mother and to be near her son, Philip W. Dierking.

She was a member of St. Lukes Methodist Church, Kansas City, MO, and a member of Zion Hill Church, Concordia MO. Bonita enjoyed sewing and donating her sewn projects to anyone who was in need. She made neckerchiefs for Boy Scout Troop 275 of KC and Boy Scout Troop 258 of Concordia, Mo. She made quilts for Project Linus, and belly bands for Homeward Bound Pug Rescue of Oklahoma. She made quilts for family members including memory quilts and baby quilts. She was a member of the Concordia American Legion Auxiliary Post 258 and a member of Missouri Women in Agriculture.

Bonita is survived by son, Philip W. Dierking (Anita Brenberger) of the home as well as numerous nieces, nephews, and cherished friends. Bonita's passing was preceded by the deaths of her parents; her brothers and their

wives—Ralph and Ethylene, Vernon and Mary Frances, Marion and Bonnie—
as well as infant George and infant sister Barbara.

Bonita loved her pug dogs – rescued and adopted. Pugs Missy, Marci, Zeus,
and Maggie were her pug family until they went to doggie heaven.
