Catherine Lee Harmon Koehler, age 68, of Olathe, Kansas, passed away suddenly on January 25, 2024.

Cathy was born to Richard and Doris (Lauritzen) Harmon on February 3, 1955, in Lincoln, Nebraska. She grew up in Weeping Water, Nebraska, where she attended kindergarten through high school graduation, played the flute in the band, and was active in the family's church. She was raised in an environment where extended family was a significant part of her growing up. Cathy attended the University of Nebraska, receiving her degree in home economics. It was there she met her husband, David. They were married May 27, 1979 and then moved to the Kansas City area where they raised their three children Emily, Joel, and Jeff. Cathy spent the majority of her adult life as a homemaker and had passions for her family, sewing, quilting, gardening, baking, travel and church ministry involvement. As known by many, she was a big Chiefs and Royals fan. She was a 50-year member of the PEO sisterhood in Olathe. Cathy was defined by her faith in the Lord Jesus Christ and her walk with Him.

She is survived by her husband David, children Emily (Mark) Hartter, Joel Koehler, Jeff (Anna) Koehler, ten grandchildren, her mother Doris Duff, sisters Debra (Dale) Parson and Janet Harmon (Tom Braz), a niece and nephew, and numerous aunts, uncles, and cousins.

Her ashes will be inurned at Olathe Memorial Cemetery in the weeks to come.
