Cynthia Lee “Cindy” Shannon, 64, of Kansas City, Missouri, passed away Tuesday, December 8, 2020, at home. Cindy passed peacefully in her sleep.

Cindy was born in Madras, Oregon, on December 23, 1955, to Joan Elizabeth (Ayers) Dinnel and James Wayne “Jay” Dinnel.

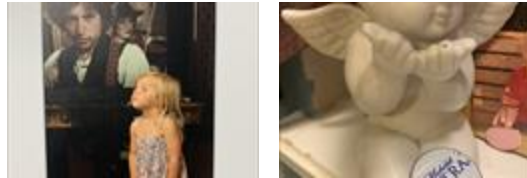

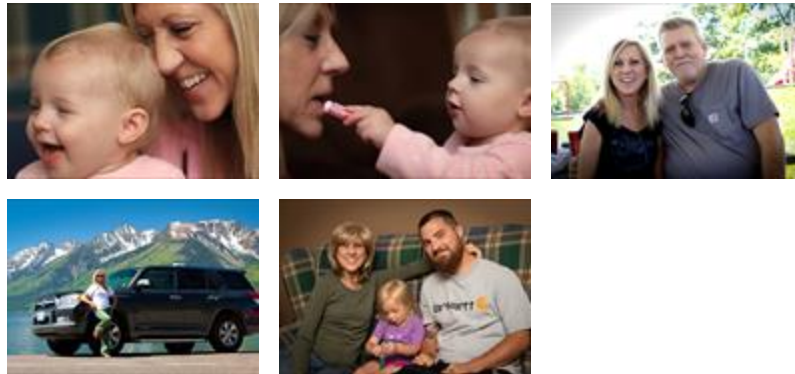
