David Wayne Vice, 54, Gladstone, MO passed away May 18, 2023. Beloved husband of Jennifer (Rodman)Vice and dedicated father to Emily and Andrew Vice. David died after a long battle with kidney cancer.

He was born in Morgan City, Louisiana to Ken and Janelle (Broussard) Vice, he was the third of seven children. He stood out with his quick wit, jovial personality and his dedication to hard work.

When he was 10 the family moved to Lafayette, Louisiana. David loved learning about the bible and in June 1985 at the age of 16, he dedicated his life to Jehovah God. Always willing to lend a hand however he could, he was known as someone you could count on and loved by all that knew him. His true pleasure was in teaching people about the Bible and what the future holds. He fulfilled the words found at 1 Thessalonians 1:3. "for we continually remember your faithful work, your loving labor and your endurance."

He could often be identified by being the loudest person in the room with his contagious laughter all while enjoying preparing a Cajun meal for family and friends.
