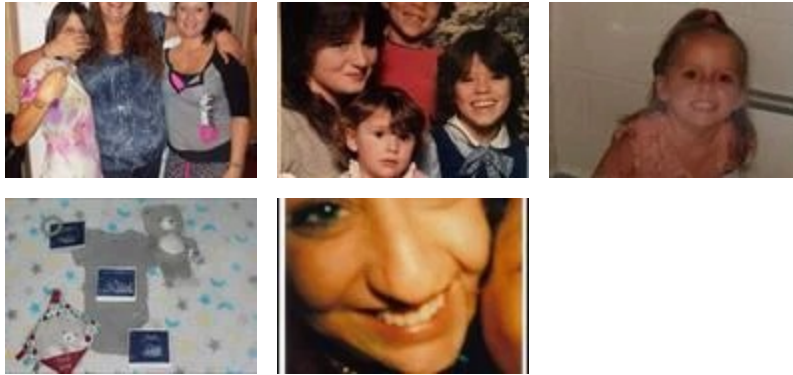
OUTLOOK PARK POMONA LAKE, KS
