



## Floyd "Tony" Edward Sipes

September 12, 1939 - October 26, 2025

Floyd "Tony" Edward Sipes of Belton, MO passed away October 26, 2025 at his home. He was born September 12, 1939 in Ft. Scott, KS to Raymond and Hallie Sipes.

Tony graduated from Center High School in 1958. He was a Parts Manager at Pappas Chevrolet and later changed vocations and became a Journeyman Electrician working for Johnson Electric in Dallas, TX. He was a Craftsman Carpenter who loved working with his hands. Tony took over a millwork business from his father-in-law, as well as building three of the houses that he lived in. He also had a love for cars. He held a world speed record in 1972 that was recognized by the American Hot Rod Association (AHRA). The record was set at the Kansas City International Raceway (KCIR) in the Formula 1, Stock J class.

When Tony was relaxing he enjoyed restoring and building street rods and antique cars. He won numerous awards for two of the street rods that he built, a 1936 Plymouth Coupe and a 1957 Chevy. Tony also enjoyed watching old westerns.

Tony was preceded in death by his father and mother; brother, Bodean (Bo) and Robert (Bob); and his grandson Danny. He leaves behind his wife Fanitta of Belton, MO; five children, daughter Denise Frazier (Johnnie) of Warsaw,

MO; son Randy Sipes (Karla) of Jay, OK; daughter Michelle Lovelace (Excell) of Lee's Summit, MO; son Christopher Urban (Dina) of Glencoe, MN; daughter Anita Urban of Kansas City, MO; 2 sisters; Janan Staub(Larry)of Denison Tx. and June Bowles( Lee)of Sherman Tx; 15 grandchildren; 23 great grandchildren.
