In his younger years, you could find him cruising the Fe and getting in karate fights. He learned sign language and even moved in with a deaf roommate for a period. The older he got, the more opinionated he became and anyone who disagreed was just plain wrong and he'd let you know. An avid Johnny Cash

and Merle Haggard fan, he picked up guitar and even took some voice lessons in his 40's. He could do a dang good version of "Are the good times really over for good". With a Pinterest account that included everything from "Hobo hand signs" to "How to measure daylight with your hand", he was a sucker for puppies, kittens, babies, and anything American.

In his later years he worked at Household Finance and later became a storm chaser. He was interviewed by Darla Jay the day Joplin Mo was hit by an EF5 tornado on May 22, 2011. He had a passion for horticulture including tomatoes, peppers of all sorts and bonsai trees.

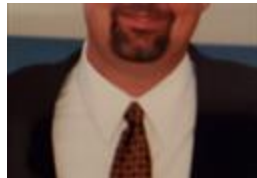
