Howard H. Newell, 78, Platte City, MO, formerly of Shawnee, KS for 25 years, passed away October 7, 2023. He was born and raised in Burlington, Wisconsin, and left home at the age of 15 to join a circus, where he wrestled alligators and bears. Howard started his professional wrestling career at the age of 16 in the Marigold Arena, Chicago, IL. He wrestled in many promotions: ASW, AWA, AJPW, BTW, CSW, CCW, CWF, CW USA, GCW, GWE, GPW, HAWAII, ICW, IWE, MLW, MMP, SLWC, SWCW, TRI-STATE, USWA, WCCW, WCW, WP, WSA, WWC, WWE, WWF. He had 1,688 documented matches and held 3 titles over a 29-year career (1961-1990). This does not include hundreds of matches as a manager or referee.

His career sent him around the world to many countries, he loved different cultures and food. Howard was an excellent cook, and everyone loved his famous chimichurri. His favorite dishes were Fish & Chips, Korean BBQ and Kimchi. He loved Elvis, Irish music, good (dark) beer and his family. Howard was the owner of LIK-NU Carpet & Upholstery Cleaning (1984-current).

Over the years with his illness so many friends and family members would come to visit, and he'd keep them all laughing and entertained with his stories. His laughter and his quick wit will be greatly missed.

Howard was preceded in death by his mother, Dorothy, his father, Dr. Frank Newell. Howard is survived by his wife of 51 years and caregiver, Judith Newell; his son Frank (Stacie); grandchildren Peyton & Bradyn and a host of friends. A celebration of Life, with snacks and drinks provided, is scheduled for Saturday October 21, 2023, from 3-6. sharing of memories, begins at 4, at the Seven Bridges Neighborhood Community Center, 17800 NW Seven Bridges Rd, Platte City, MO 64079.
