James “Jamie” Robert Archer, 74, of Kansas City, Mo., passed away on Saturday, October 10, 2020, of cancer. He will be remembered by family and friends in a private memorial service.

After serving some time in the state correctional system as a young man, he went on to work for a local politician, and at Don Bosco Center in Kansas City, Mo.
