Larry Dale Harris, 75, of Independence, Missouri passed away peacefully at his home on February 13th, 2020.

Larry was born on November 5th, 1944 in Kansas City, Missouri to William and Helen Harris. He graduated from Northeast High School and attended University of Central Missouri, shortly before enlisting in the US Army as an infantryman in the Vietnam War. He began his career in 1973 with the Independence Police Department as a police officer. He retired in 2002 but stayed in the reserves another 10 years.
