



Lawrence Raymond Noah III

October 1, 1945 - April 26, 2021

Sargent Lawrence (Larry) Raymond Noah III, 75, died peacefully at home in Independence, MO on April 26, 2021. A veteran of the Vietnam War, he was awarded several medals including an Army Commendation Medal.

Larry was born on October 1, 1945 in Spartanburg, SC to Lawrence and Mary Keller Noah. In 1966 after attending two years of college at Davidson in North Carolina Larry joined the army, where he met Mildred (Millie) Bearce. After a brief whirlwind romance, they were married over Christmas leave in Kansas City, MO in 1966.

A natural mathematician he opened a tax preparation business in 1981. He became an enrolled agent in 1985, scoring in the top 1% in the nation.

He is survived by his daughters; Caroline McBride and her husband Keith, Mary Sullivan and her husband Dave; his grandchildren Stephon, Bailey, Noah; and his great-grandchild Jayden. He is preceded in death by his wife, Mildred; and his granddaughter, Jordan, who died in infancy.
