Lenna Jayne (Stanley) King was born to Edwin and Hazel Stanley on January 14, 1934 in Andover, Missouri and passed away Thursday, June 20, 2019 at the age of 85, surrounded by family.

In 1998, they decided to move back to Missouri to be closer to more family. They attended many ballgames, recitals and various events of the many grandkids, as well as numerous family gatherings she loved to help plan, as well as prepare favorite dishes.

She married Charles Trullinger in 1950, Donald Wilson in 1956, August Kaufman in 1961 and Ralph King in 1989 up until his death June 6, 2019.
