Margie was a tiny ball of Betty Hutton energy, always finding and planting a new flower or vegetable and anxious to share the outcome with us. She was a very proud product of Texas who had countless memories of her childhood there and told us stories of a drive-in post office and growing up in a small town where there were no strangers and there was an open seat at every table ... reserved for an unknown guest or a wandering family member. Knowing Margie and hearing her stories of growing up in Texas was the material for a Hemingway novel. she was a Gem and a constant delight for my aunt Kathrine, who was Margie's best friend. I was a high school student at the time, living with my aunt and uncle while my mother was working as a cosmetician in a Youngstown, Ohio department store. I didn't realize it at the time, but I was the child Woody and Katie never had. They were wonderful to me and gave me the values I live by today.*

Generous and full of stories of Texas and her times there. Miss Her? Margie was a part of my life. Like you who read this piece, I am sorry to lose her, but comforted in the belief that she has gone to a better place where she lives among her collection of miniature perfume bottles and entertains the Lord with stories of Texas and Evanvsville and friends like us, who miss her and who still remember visiting her house on the little lake where friendly deer and a rainbow of birds still watch over the place.*
