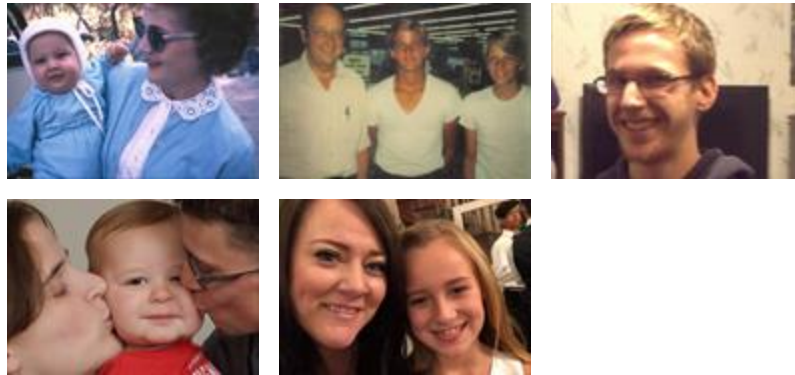
Allison Hopkins
