Michael Scott Fee, the underground hip-hop artist, better known as Scotty Fee, or Mesafee, lost his battle with congestive heart failure, due to complications of muscular dystrophy on November 14th 11:45pm. He was 23 years old.

He was survived by his parents, Chanelle Johnson of Kansas City, Ks, and Michael Allen Fee of Oak Grove, Mo. Two older sisters Anastasia Johnson 28, and Elizabeth Fee 26, and one older brother Joshua Fee 25, caretaker, and best friend.
