Michael (Mike) Lynn Morgan, 73, of Belton, Missouri, passed away on Monday, January 2, 2023, surrounded by his family and loved ones. Mike was born July 30, 1949, in Miami, OK, to the union of Harry and Anita (Sapan) Morgan.
