Rebecca Michele Steiner, born June 29, 1976, in Kansas City, Missouri, to Pastor James and Beverly Russell. Rebecca Michele Steiner loved Jesus, family, friends, and music, in that order. She was known affectionately as Becky, Becca, Aunt B, and Princess. She graduated from Providence Christian Academy high school and Baptist Bible College where she developed a deep and enduring relationship with our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Classically trained at the UMKC Conservatory of Music as a vocal major with a piano minor, Becky became a concert pianist and accomplished performing artist with an absolutely angelic voice. Her love of music and especially singing praises to the Lord was magical. Becky's collection of original songs, hymns, and sheet music was matched only by her collection of dazzling shoes. She wrote, arranged, played, sang, and recorded over 80 songs on 8 solo albums, heard on the radio from Europe to Australia. Becky, also performed an annual Christmas concert, which was the highlight of the holiday season every year for those lucky enough to attend.

As worship leader at Blue Springs Baptist Temple for nearly 20 years, Becky was a lighthouse in the darkness. She had a mesmerizing presence and was constantly drawing people in and bringing them to Jesus with a kind word, a helping hand, and most of all a warm and inviting smile. Her laughter and

energy was infectious, and everyone that came near her was forever touched by her beauty and grace.

When she wasn't at church, Becca was touching the lives of hundreds as a librarian, founder and president of a successful consulting business, and graduate student pursuing her Master of Music Therapy degree at the University of Kansas. Becca also loved traveling the world, getting her passport stamped, and exploring new places and cultures with her family and friends. She spread God's love around the globe to over 80 cities in 34 states and 16 different countries, but Paris, France was always her favorite.

Rebecca passed away peacefully on Oct 11, 2021 at the age of 45. She is survived by her parents, James and Beverly, brother Jim, adoring husband Patrick, and faithful, beloved puppy, Yoda. She is remembered and celebrated today and every day through the passion she left behind: her words to you would be "Love Jesus Christ, accept Him into your heart and life as your Savior, and go be the servant God has called you to be!"
