The love of my life has left this earth. I was so fortunate to have him in my life for going on 40 years.

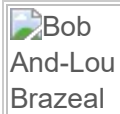
I have never met anybody more kind and loving than Rick was. The years we spent together were so full of love and adventures and memorable times.
