Robert is preceded in death by his Aunt Babe and Uncle Elmer of Cameron Missouri as well as Peter and Wendys son Colin.

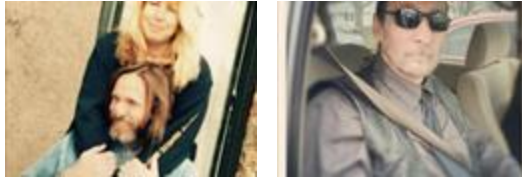
