Todd Howard Milford 52, of Independence, MO went to be with the Lord on Friday, September 2nd after tragically suffering a massive stroke. He entered the world on February 25, 1964 to parents Raymond D. and Norma Jean (Beemer) Milford in Kansas City. Todd spent his young life in Laclede, MO helping on the farm, developing a love for the outdoors, and bringing his enjoyment of nature to life in drawings and paintings.

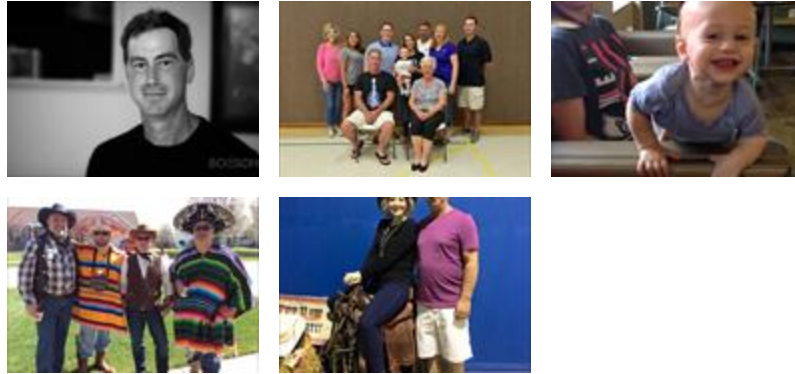
