Wayne L. Wilson, 79, of Platte City, MO passed away on January 16, 2022 at Kansas City Hospice House.

Wayne was born and raised in Miami, Florida where he completed high school and then joined the Navy in 1962, during the Cuban Missile Crisis.

After military service and attending several universities, he joined the Binks Manufacturing Co. of Chicago in 1979 and represented the Carolinas' from his home in Charlotte. He eventually became one of the corporation's national managers out of his facility in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Wayne traveled extensively to the Near East, Western Europe and to the Caribbean while in the military and also privately.

In 2003 he moved to Platte City, MO from Des Moines to be closer to his daughter Karen, her husband Lonnie and granddaughters Sarah, Jenna and Allison.

In 2006 Wayne was granted a U.S. patent for an innovative series of industrial/environmental machines.

He was a life-long enthusiast of the Fine Arts and worked as a volunteer at the

Nelson-Atkins Museum of Art.
